Our aim working towards re registration is embedding those fundamental practices that are aligned with Quality Area 2 and Quality Area 3.

Children's health and safety encompasses the elements of wellbeing and comfort, health practices and procedures and their healthy lifestyle, as well as supervision, incident and emergency management and child protection.

The physical environment includes not only being fit for purpose and the upkeep but also your environment being inclusive, resources supporting play-based learning and being environmentally responsible.

Our visits, training and information base will be focused on these areas to help you provide the highest quality care for your children and to ensure you meet all standards and regularity requirements. While this may mean some changes to practises or environments, especially outdoor forts and fencing it is important to remember that these are only to bring you in line with changing requirements of early education and care.

Please keep up the Daily Safety Checklist and mark down areas of concern for you to discuss with your Coordinator.
