Advise children of dangers and supervise 2. Teach children road rules as part of your embedded practices 3. Ensure medication with you at all times 4. Ensure regular servicing and carry required phone numbers and relevant vehicle details 5. Supervision and safety rpractices to be adhered to. <p>Try and use drop off zone if available to ensure safe practices</p> <p>Provide children with knowledge and instructions to help prepare them for safe travel, arrival and departures</p>
